



Day 1. Depart Ireland. Arrive Munich, Passau, Embark Ship.

Fly from Ireland and arrive in Munich, where you will be met and transferred to your river ship, docked on the Danube River.

Day 2. Passau.

Tonight, enjoy a traditional Bavarian experience on board. Sample delicious local beer and snacks, accompanied by traditional folk music, song, and dance. In the beautiful city of Passau, enjoy a guided walking tour, taking in the historic sights as you roam the cobblestone lanes of the Altstadt.

Dav 3. Linz.

Day 5. Vienna.

Embrace the elegance of Vienna as you drive around the Ringstrasse, taking in some of the city's most famous buildings. Day 6. Bratislava.



Day 7. Budapest.

Day 8. Depart Budapest, Arrive Ireland.

After breakfast, disembark your river ship and transfer to the airport for your return flight to Ireland.

Day 1. Depart Ireland, Arrive Munich.

Day 2. Bamberg.

The World Heritage-listed city of Bamberg beckons today as you explore the beautiful city centre with a local guide. As you meander through the canal-crossed streets, you'll discover a range of historic churches and buildings.

Day 3. Würzburg.

Verdant hills and rich vineyards sit on the edge of Würzburg, with the Main River a prominent feature of this stunning cityscape.

The architectural beauty that further defines Würzburg is on show today as you admire its magnificent baroque palace from the gardens of the Würzburg Residence. Here, a walk through the Würzburg Court Garden is a delight, with its terraced gardens and serene water basin encircled by yew trees.

Day 4. Miltenberg.

Be greeted by the friendly locals of Miltenberg and learn about their culture as you are welcomed into their homes for coffee and cake. Explore this beautifully evocative town, perfectly positioned at the confluence of the Tauber and Main rivers, and uncover its intriguing history. Return to your ship and enjoy time at leisure. As the sun sets, watch the lights of medieval towns slip past as you cruise through the night.

Day 5. Rüdesheim, Rhine Gorge.

Dock in Rüdesheim, a pretty Rhine Valley wine town. Here, the Winzerexpress minitrain will take you through the town to Siegfried's Mechanical Musical Instrument Museum, which houses the most beautiful collection of automated musical instruments in Germany. From its dainty music boxes to an enormous orchestrion. you're sure to gain a fascinating insight into the history of music and the evolution of various instruments. Later, back on board, cruise through the Rhine Gorge, considered to be the most beautiful section of the Rhine River.

Day 6. Cologne, Brühl.


Arrive in Cologne and travel south to the Rhineland town of Brühl. Visit the grand 18th-century castle of Augustusburg. Built by Archbishop Clemens August, this is one of the region's finest examples of German rococo architecture in the country. Later, return to Cologne for free time.

Day 7. Amsterdam.

Clustered by historic houses and studded with low bridges, Amsterdam's network of 17th-

century canals lends the city its nickname: 'the Venice of the North'. Today, board a glass-top boat and glide past the city's waterside facades with a local guide. Back on land, enjoy some free time before a Farewell Dinner on board.

Day 8. Depart Amsterdam, Arrive Ireland. This morning, you will be transferred to the airport for your flight home.











Travelling along the Danube, Main and Rhine, you'll enjoy a variety of experiences as well as ample free time to discover at your own pace. From sampling local delicacies in Vienna to a visit to Augustusburg Castle in Brühl, this 4* river cruise represents marvellous value.

Day 6. Würzburg.

Today, discover the architectural beauty of

the stunning city of Würzburg as you visit the gardens of the Würzburg Residence.

Day 7. Bamberg.

Cruise along the last stretch of the Main River before arriving at Bamberg. Choose between an afternoon of free time or a guided tour.

Day 8. Nuremberg.

Explore Nuremberg, the site of Hitler's now infamous rallies. Cruise the Main-Danube Canal. crossing Europe's Continental Divide thanks to the canal's 16 stair-step locks.

Day 9. Regensburg.

Discover medieval Regensburg and see the impressive 12th-century Stone Bridge that arches gracefully across the water. This evening, enjoy an authentic Bavarian experience on board.

Day 10. Passau.

As you enjoy breakfast, arrive in the 'Three Rivers City' of Passau, where the rivers Inn and Ilz join the Danube. Join an optional tour to Cesky Krumlov in the Czech Republic, or travel to Salzburg and enjoy sights from 'The Sound of Music'. Alternatively, enjoy a relaxing day sailing to Linz.

Day 11. Melk, Dürnstein.

Join a local guide to see Melk Abbey, an active Benedictine monastery since 1089. Cruise through the picturesque Wachau Valley, then continue to Dürnstein, where you have a free afternoon to explore. You may also wish to join an optional bike ride from Melk to Durnstein.

Day 12. Vienna.

Day 2. Régua, Lamego, Pinhão.



Today board a coach and set off for the glorious Spanish city of Salamanca. This gorgeous city boasts sunlit sandstone buildings along with a majestic city square. Enjoy a Flamenco show with lunch and be entranced by captivating Flamenco dancers as they astound you with their stomping feet

in a fiery performance. Back on board this evening, savour a traditional Portuguese BBQ dinner.

On arrival, enjoy free time to explore this gorgeous, vibrant town as you please. Tonight, be treated to an energetic performance of traditional Portuguese folk music back on board at a special Captain's Dinner.

Day 7. Vila Nova de Gaia, Porto.

Join a tour of Porto, marvelling at the city's most famous attractions, and visiting a local port winery for a tour and tasting. This afternoon explore Porto at leisure. Following the Croatian War of Independence, Vukovar's economy, infrastructure and culture were in disarray. However, today you will see the efforts taken to restore this city to its former glory. Visit the Vukovar City Museum, hidden inside Eltz Manor and enjoy the chance to wander through the castle complex.

Day 5. Belgrade.

Discover the traditional Serbian way of life with a local family in the village of Jarak. Take a tour of their home and barn to meet the resident farm animals. Stroll through the family's fruit orchards to learn about the brewing process


Day 6. Iron Gates.



Dock in Rüdesheim and ride the Winzerexpress mini train through the town to Siegfried's Mechanical Musical Instrument Museum. Here, discover a magnificent collection of automated musical instruments. Follow the scent of gingerbread to the Old Town where you'll find Rüdesheim's charming Christmas market in full swing. Be sure to call in on the famous Käthe Wohlfahrt Christmas store for decorations and gifts.

Day 6. Strasbourg.

Arrive in Strasbourg, the Alsatian city that straddles the border between France and Germany. Discover the picturesque sites on a guided tour and enjoy the pretty scenery. You will also have time to explore the Christkindelsmärik Christmas market, the oldest in France. More than 300 chalet-style stalls are strung throughout the city's historic district

with a towering Christmas tree at its centre. If you're feeling peckish, this is the perfect opportunity to taste some local treats. Return to your river ship for a Farewell Dinner.

Day 7. Breisach.

Disembark in Breisach to explore the Black Forest region. Travel by coach, past the skybound pine and birch trees blanketing the mountainsides, to the scenic village of Triberg.

Day 8. Disembark Ship, Depart Basel.


After breakfast on board, disembark and be transferred to Basel airport for your return flight to Ireland.


